The events of Pearl Harbor have just persuaded President FDR to sign Executive Order 9066, requiring all Japanese Americans to immediately pack and ready their affairs for transport to "re-location" camps like Manzanar.

The war's boom time economy is drawing Blacks from the Deep South for high-paying jobs and Los Angeles has its share of factories hiring. When the Goodwin's discover a young Japanese American who has refused to be relocated, the family is faced with coming to terms with their own values as they debate and struggle with doing the right thing.
