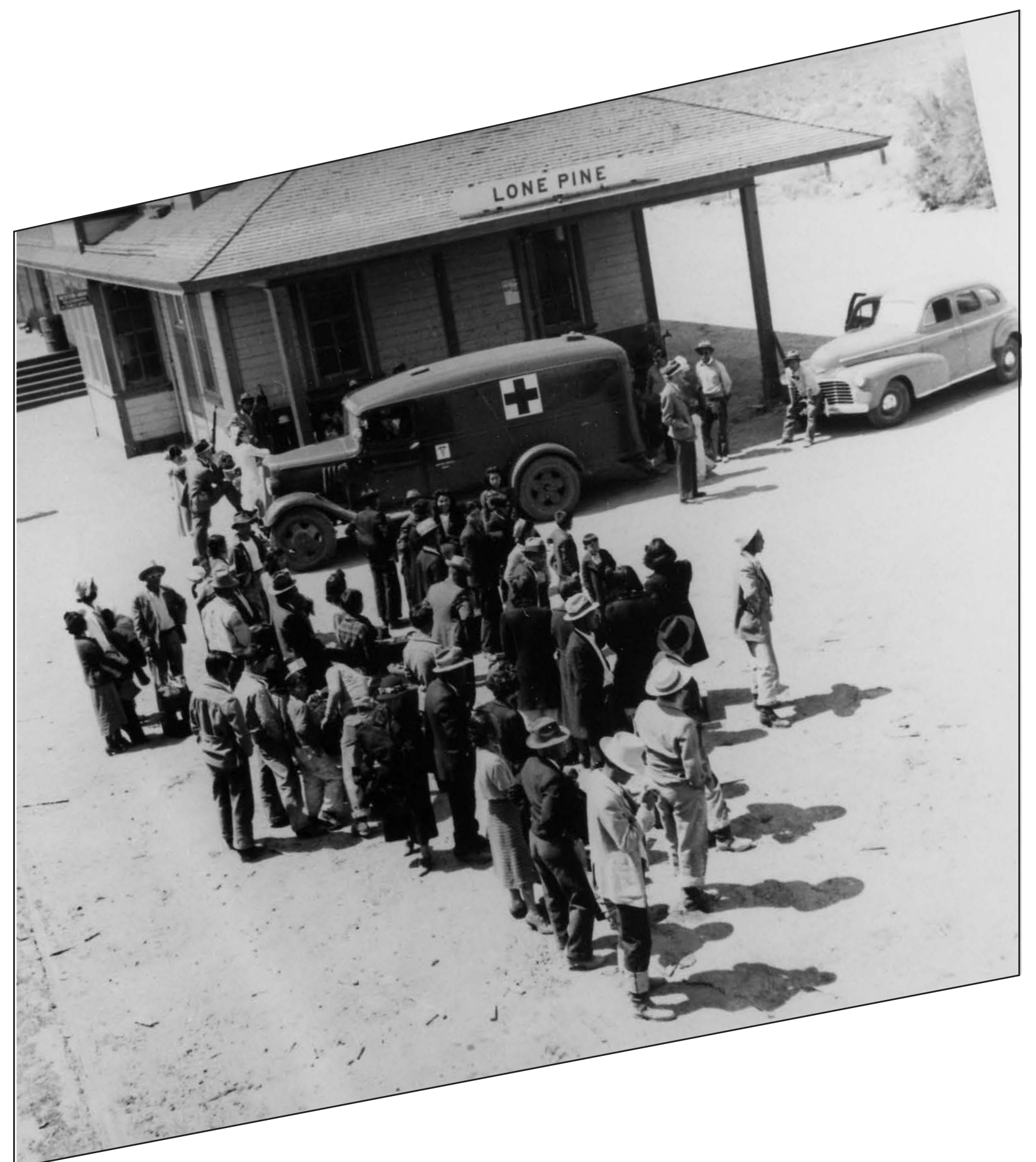

The 1942 establishment of Manzanar War Relocation Center brought more than 10,000 individuals of Japanese ancestry from the West Coast to the rural Owens Valley. Owens Valley residents reacted in a variety of ways to this new community.

Dr. Art Hansen, Emeritus Director of the California State University, Fullerton Japanese American Oral History Project, will join us for **Day of Remembrance**, an annual observation of the anniversary of Executive Order 9066, to speak on the local responses to Manzanar War Relocation Center. His talks will mark both the 70th anniversary of the executive order, which enabled the forced removal of more than 110,000 United States citizens or residents of Japanese ancestry from the West Coast, and the 35th anniversary of the university's publication, *Camp and Community*:

*Manzanar and the Owens Valley*, edited by Jessie A. Garrett and Ronald C. Larson.
