Manzanar NHS is located at 5001 Hwy. 395, Independence, CA 93526, between Independence and Lone Pine.

Volunteers must be at least 15 years old and able to work outdoors. The work is **physically demanding**, but there will be a variety of tasks. Previous experience is helpful, but all you need is an interest in history and a willingness to be covered with dirt and/or spattered with paint.

Volunteers for a full day or multiple days are preferred. We will meet each day at 7:30 a.m. in the visitor center parking lot and work until 3:30 p.m. **Advance sign-up required.**
